Rhett was adopted and is now living a great life with his sister, Scarlett O'Hara, a puppy mill survivor saved from the Brunswick County puppy mill bust in 2014. Rhett and Scarlet's mother quite simply, adore her dogs. Rhett's mother often calls him the "One eyed wonder" and Scarlet thinks he is her "southern gentleman" and quite handsome!
